INTERNATIONAL FLIGHTS

This information is understood to be valid as at 2nd May 2022. Due to the rapid change in requirements this information is provided as a guide and the final obligation remains with the passenger to confirm with their destination country (and any countries of transit) as to the latest requirements. Normal travel requirements such as passport validity, travel visas, certificate of vaccination etc. also apply.

A: TRAVEL INTO PORT MORESBY, PAPUA NEW GUINEA

Ensure you are aware of the following requirements and restrictions when travelling to Papua New Guinea (PNG).

- National Pandemic Act 2020 No.2 International Travel Measures (effective 5th August 2022)
- 1. Controller Approval is no longer required for travel into PNG.
- 2. Pre-departure PCR testing for flights to PNG is no longer required
- 3. Passengers do not need to complete the online PNG Health Declaration
- 4. Passengers arriving from India and Philippines are no longer required to quarantine for arrivals
- 5. Covid-19 testing on arrival for all international passengers is no longer required.

WHAT TO PRESENT AT THE TIME OF CHECK-IN FOR INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL TO PORT MORESBY

- 1. Normal Travel Documents
- 2. Proof of Vaccination
 - PNG Citizens, Permanent Residences or persons under 18 years of age, are not required to be vaccinated against Covid-19 for travel to PNG.
 - Non-PNG Citizens, 18 years old and above need to be fully vaccinated against Covid-19 prior to travel to PNG. Fully vaccinated means at least two (2) doses of any vaccine accepted by PNG with the last dose taken at least fourteen (14) days prior to arrival. One dose of Janssen/Johnson & Johnson is acceptable in lieu.

- Pfizer-BioNTech 2 Doses
- Moderna 2 Doses
- Johnson & Johnson 1 Dose

- CoronaVac Sinovac 2 Doses
- Novavax 2 Doses
- Covaxin (Bharat Biotech) 2 Doses
- Covovax (SIINVX-CoV2373) 2 Doses
